

Selection Procedure

A Selection Committee receives and reviews all nominations and select award designees. The committee may request additional information from a nominator. Additional letters of recommendation are not required, but recommended.

Individuals nominated for the Distinguished Alumni Award and not chosen will continue to be eligible for two years following the initial nomination process without re-nomination.

September – December 1

Completed nomination will be accepted.

December 1 – January 15

Selection Committee will contact those individuals who need to complete an application. Applications are due January 15. No forms will be accepted after January 15; all forms must be postmarked by January 15.

March

June

MHS Distinguished Alum will be recognized & honored during the Graduation Ceremony.
